Important Information - Passport and Visa Information for Tanzania & Kenya (US Passport Holders)

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

Tourist visas are required for US passport holders to enter Tanzania & Kenya. You must have at least two blank pages in a valid passport per country you are visiting. Passports must be valid for 6 months past departure from the last country visited.

Tanzania tourist visa costs: USD100 per person.

We strongly recommend that you pre-apply for your Tanzania visa prior to travel via https://eservices.immigration.go.tz/visa to avoid lengthy application lines/process on arrival at Kilimanjaro Airport (JRO). E-visa approval can take up to 2 weeks, so please allow plenty of time for this process. HOWEVER, visas are only valid for 90 days from date of issue, so do not apply TOO early.

Kenya tourist visa costs: USD50 per person, single entry Visas are available upon arrival, or pre-application via http://evisa.go.ke/evisa.html

Hills of Africa Travel will provide details for the E-visa application process for both countries.

Important Information - Luggage Requirements (Light Aircraft Charter Flights)

On ALL light aircrafts, only soft bags will be accepted - no hard suitcases, as they physically cannot fit into the aircraft. Duffel bags without wheels are preferred. This includes camera equipment and hand luggage.

Weight Limits: Luggage, including camera equipment and hand luggage, is restricted on charter flights to 15kg (33 lbs) per person.

Luggage Dimensions: The maximum dimensions of the soft bags are as follows: 25cm (10 in) wide x 30cm (12in) high x 62cm (24in) long (to fit through the opening of the cargo hold). Please keep in mind that the baggage compartments on the light aircraft are only 25 cm (10in) high, so the pilots must be able to manipulate the bag into the compartment.

Passenger Weight Limits: Passengers exceeding the personal weight limits indicated below MUST advise us in advance to confirm if an extra seat must be purchased. *Please remember that these restrictions are imposed by the airline to ensure the safety of all passengers and crew.*

Kenya & Tanzania - MALE passengers weighing 85kg (188lbs) or more, FEMALE passengers weighing 65kg (143lbs) or more, please advise us in advance

Important Information - Health - Malaria

Malaria is always a concern when traveling to Africa. Your doctor will best prescribe the necessary medications based on the areas you are traveling to.

Important Information - Yellow Fever Advisory

Yellow Fever Advisory

The yellow fever virus is found in tropical and subtropical areas of Africa and South America. The virus is spread to people by the bite of an infected mosquito. Yellow fever is a very rare cause of illness in U.S. travelers, however to prevent getting sick from yellow fever, use insect repellent, wear long-sleeved shirts and long pants, and get vaccinated.

The International Certificate of Vaccination for Yellow Fever is:

• required in all countries IF you have traveled from/through a known Yellow Fever area/country in the past 6 months. This includes travel in Africa or Central/South America.

Please be certain to arrange for Yellow Fever vaccination at least two weeks prior to travel. You will want to keep your Yellow Fever vaccination certificate with your passport at all times.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Countries may change their vaccination requirements with out notice In some instances border agents may use their discretion to require on-site vaccination, despite officially stated requirements.

Important Information - Plastic Bags Banned

Many countries around the world have moved to ban the use of plastic bags in an effort to reduce litter and the long-term, negative impacts upon the environment.

The ban includes:

- Plastic shopping bags
- Single-use plastic bags, with or without handles
- Zip top plastic bags
- Duty-free bags

Countries in our travel sphere with laws banning plastic bags:

- Tanzania
- Kenya

Please note that some countries are stricter in enforcing this ban than others.

Suggested alternatives to plastic bags would include packing cubes or dry sacks, similar to those used for camping or kayaking. There are many options available, and easy to find online.

Important Information - Local Currencies

Prior to travel it is important to be certain your bank and credit card issuers know you will be traveling abroad so your cards are not locked due to security concerns.

USD is accepted throughout Eastern Africa for tips and other purchases. Please be aware that correct change may not be given.

Tanzania: Tanzanian Shilling Credit cards (Visa, American Express, and MasterCard) are accepted in most of the hotels and lodges and the larger established curio shops, but not in many camps, nor at most airport coffee/snack shops. Most establishments will add on a 2% - 10% surcharge on all credit card transactions. There are ATMs in larger towns which will usually accept Visa/Swift/Delta cash advances, but will only provide Tanzanian Shillings.

Kenya: Kenyan Shilling - Visitors to Kenya should change foreign currency at banks, bureau de change or authorized hotels. The easiest currencies to exchange are USD, Pounds sterling, and EURO. There are no restrictions on the amount of foreign currency that can be brought into Kenya. Before departure, travelers are advised to convert any excess Kenya shillings into foreign currency at a bank or Bureau de Change before departure. Anyone wishing to take more than 500,000 Kenya Shillings out of the country will require written authorization from the Central Bank. Many hotels and restaurants accept major credit cards (MasterCard, Visa, Diners Club, and American Express). Most banks in Kenya are equipped to advance cash on credit cards.

Welcome to Tanzania! Once you have landed at Kilimanjaro International Airport you will need to clear customs & immigration and collect your luggage.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION - US passports require visas to enter Tanzania AND must have at least two empty pages in their passports for each country visited. Passports must be valid for at least 6 months from the date of departure from the last country visited.

Tanzania tourist visa costs: USD100 per person.

Please have exact amount in cash for visas as no change will be given.

We strongly recommend that you pre-apply for your Tanzania visa prior to travel via https://eservices.immigration.go.tz/visa to avoid lengthy application lines/process on arrival at Kilimanjaro Airport (JRO). E-visa approval can take up to 2 weeks, so please allow plenty of time for this process. HOWEVER, visas are only valid for 90 days from date of issue, so do not apply TOO early.

You will then proceed to the Arrivals Hall and look for your name on a sign.



Guests at Lemala Mpingo Ridge will enjoy a real sense of wilderness and excellent game viewing, and it's both a relaxing standalone destination and a great place to start a safari that also combines Lemala properties in the Ngorongoro Crater and Serengeti.

Tarangire National Park

With your private guide, you'll be exploring Tarangire National Park. Located approximately 110 kms southwest of Arusha, covering an area of approximately 2,600 sq kms, this park has a particularly high concentration of wildlife during the dry season from June to October, mainly congregating along the Tarangire River.

The park is also an ornithologists paradise with more than 300 species of birds, including the largest bird in the world, the ostrich and the heaviest bird that can fly, the Kori Bustard.

The best game viewing months are generally between June and October but for bird viewing is recommended to visit between the months of October and May.

NOTE: Tsetse flies can be quite bothersome in Tarangire area. Please avoid wearing blue or black clothing, as these colors attract these biting flies.

Today your guide will drive you up into lush **Ngorongoro Highlands** where forests, monkeys, coffee farms and lush gardens are the norm. You will stop en route for a picnic and some game viewing in **Lake Manyara National Park**. *Departure time will be confirmed the prior evening by your guide*.

Tanzania - Lake Manyara National Park

LAKE MANYARA NATIONAL PARK - Although Lake Manyara National Park is only 125 square miles, the shallow, alkaline lake consumes the majority of this area. The land portion of the Park is situated between the lake and the sheer rock walls of the Rift Valley escarpment towering 2,000 feet above. The Park is home to three distinct habitats including a lush groundwater forest, open floodplains and acacia woodlands. In just a two-hour round-trip foray into the Park, it is possible to see all the main highlights, offering the ideal quick safari for travelers who are short on time.

From the entrance gate, the road winds through an expanse of lush jungle-like groundwater forest where hundred-strong baboon troops lounge nonchalantly along the roadside, blue monkeys scamper nimbly between the ancient mahogany trees, dainty bushbuck tread warily through the shadows, and outsized forest hornbills honk cacophonously in the high canopy.

Contrasting with the intimacy of the forest is the grassy floodplain and its expansive views eastward across the alkaline lake to the jagged blue volcanic peaks that rise from the endless Maasai Steppes. Large buffalo, wildebeest and zebra herds congregate on these grassy plains, as do giraffes - some so dark in coloration that they appear to be black from a distance.

Lake Manyara National Park is a birding paradise, especially for waterfowl and migrants. Its lush green forests are one of the best places to see leopards. Lions hunt on the grassy shores of the lake and are known for their habit of climbing trees. Superb game viewing is offered throughout the year, but is at its peak from December to February and from August to September.

You will spend today exploring this world famous wildlife area with your guide with a drive into the Ngorongoro Crater.

THE NGORONGORO CRATER - The Ngorongoro Conservation Area (NCA) is an extensive highland area along the eastern arm of the Rift Valley, with the world-renowned Ngorongoro Crater as its focal point. Not a national park in the strict sense of the word, the NCA was established to conserve wildlife and other natural resources, as well as to safeguard the interests of indigenous people and promote tourism. Thus, guests on safari have the unique experience of seeing Maasai herdsmen whose cattle graze side by side with the tremendous variety of wildlife found in the area.

Unmatched for its natural variety, there are few places on earth where such a tremendous diversity of landscapes exist inside a region this size. Apart from its wildlife riches, the NCA is also of great archaeological importance, with the remains of some of mankind's earliest ancestors discovered in the area.

The largest intact caldera in the world, the Ngorongoro Crater shelters one of the most beautiful wildlife havens anywhere. A permanent population of more than 30,000 animals inhabits a mere square 260km (100 square miles) in the 600m (2,000 ft)

deep crater, making this one of the few places in Africa where guests stand a great chance of seeing the entire Big Five in the course of a single game drive.

Whilst at Nimali Mara, you will enjoy shared game drives in the northern Serengeti National Park.

An untouched wilderness region, the northern Serengeti's Mara River area is relatively inaccessible and devoid of tourists. Comprising a vast pristine area of wooded rolling hills interspersed with open grassy patches and large granite outcrops, the Northern Serengeti boasts stunning landscapes and optimal wildlife viewing.

During the dry season, the Mara River famously transforms to a wild stampede with massive herds of wildebeest and zebra thundering across the river, while enormous Nile crocodiles lurk just below the murky surface.

Patience is key in the Northern Serengeti - the wildebeest like to have fun and play games with you. Often they will decide, OK it's time to cross, and then they get spooked; something's not quite right, so they change their minds. So enjoy the greatest miracle on earth, this is nature at it's finest.

July / August / September / October The wildebeest rapidly deplete the grass and water in the Western Corridor and Grumeti and start to move on. In a typical year the migration can be spread over huge distances, with the first zebra herds arriving in the northern Serengeti by early July and big herds of wildebeest following later in the month. In a dry year, the first wildebeest could be near the Mara River the only decent permanent water in the eco-system by early July; in a wet year, by mid-August. If conditions are very good, i.e. there is plenty of grass and water, the herds will be spread out all the way from Seronera to the Mara River.

The short grass, annual wildebeest migration crossing the Mara River from the Serengeti and the huge lion population are all contributory factors that make the Masai Mara such a popular destination for film-makers and tourists alike! The great migration is at its best from late August to November as the herds cross into the Masai Mara from the Serengeti in the south. This makes for a spectacular experience, nicknamed the greatest show on earth. The herds enter the Mara from the west and gather on the plains for a few months until the rains break on the southern plains of the Serengeti in December, when they return south. Whether you are here in the migration season, or not, you will have a fantastic few days of game viewing as there are amazing game viewing opportunities in the Mara from the resident game.

The major difference between a safari in the Masai Mara compared to the Serengeti is that you can drive off-road throughout the Masai Mara, as opposed to only in designated areas of the Serengeti. This means that your game viewing in the Mara is guaranteed to be up close and personal. The Mara is year-round gameviewing destination and an absolute must-see. There is no better place to see Africa's big 5 than here and the concentration and quality of animal sightings is unsurpassed anywhere on the African continent.

Operators in the Mara and the private concessions of the Mara Conservation Area offer daily game drives, walking safaris, night game drives and even hot-air ballooning for a different view of the migration. The Mara is also a great place for getting to know the colourful Maasai culture. This fearsome and historically nomadic tribe is truly fascinating and most operators offer the chance to visit a Maasai homestead, or manyatta.
